

CALL FOR EDITOR-IN-CHIEF OF COMMONWEALTH

Commonwealth: A Journal of Pennsylvania Politics and Policy is seeking applications for a new Editor-in-Chief to start in early 2022. *Commonwealth* is an open-access journal covering a broad range of topics related to the politics, policy and political history of Pennsylvania. *Commonwealth* is interdisciplinary in nature, appealing to scholars and practitioners in fields such as political science, public administration, public policy and history. The journal publishes one online issue per year and a biennial book, *Pennsylvania Politics and Policy: A Commonwealth Reader*.

The appointment as Editor-in-Chief will be for a period of three years, with the possible extension of a second term. The Editor-in-Chief is responsible for naming the Editorial Board, soliciting manuscripts, selecting reviewers for manuscripts, making final publication decisions on articles, and working with Temple University Press to copy edit and bring journal issues and books to publication.

- A letter describing how the applicant's publishing and teaching background relate to the topics covered by *Commonwealth*, and a statement of the applicant's vision for the journal during their tenure as Editor-in-Chief.
